Practices begin on November 19th. Games begin the weekend of Dec 17th. Games generally last 60 minutes and are scheduled every 1 1/2 hrs. Spectator seating will vary from gym to gym. Most elementary schools have limited seating. A minimum of 9 regular season games are played. No food or drink in any gyms. **Team formation:** For the most part players are grouped on teams formed by elementary geographical location, however when necessary PAA will mix players from several geographical locations when area teams are full.

PAA/YOUTH BASKETBALL - 2011/2012 Season

Welcome It is our goal to provide you and your child with the best possible basketball experience.

Practices begin in mid to late November (no practices are held during the school Thanksgiving/Christmas vacation period or on other holidays). Gym facilities are requested at all elementary, middle schools and high schools in the Peninsula School District. Our practice times are dependent upon school program needs and other community use of these facilities. Teams generally practice once a week for one hour. Most teams will practice one weekday and once on Saturday until games begin. Practice times are assigned to teams by PAA./Youth. Consideration is taken for special needs of coaches. However, PAA./Youth cannot accommodate special requests regarding practices days or times for your child. For example we cannot guarantee your child will be on a team that practices on Tues. and not on Wed. You will be contacted by your child's coach after Nov. 16th.

Games begin the weekend of Dec 19th. Games generally last 60 minutes and are scheduled every 1 1/2 hrs. Spectator seating will vary from gym to gym. Most elementary schools have limited seating. A minimum of 9 regular season games are played.

Registration: Begins the week of September 28th and concludes on Monday, October 19th. Forms will be available online at our website or at our office at the new Hope Center/Boys and Girls Club. Late registrations are accepted after October 19th on an availability basis only.

Registration will also be available online, beginning September 13th

Program cost is \$115.00 per child for grades 1/2 and \$125.00 for grades 3-12. Registration is \$10 more for those received after October 17th. There is also an \$25.00 charge for a PAA/Youth jersey, if you do not have one from the sports seasons. This jersey is a standard piece of equipment for participation in our programs. If you are not sure about sizes, they run as follows: YM - 10/12, YL - 14/16 and then into adult sizes S, M, L and XL. Jerseys tend to run a little small and are made of a synthetic fabric that does not shrink. For more information contact the PAA Hotline at 858-7678.

Program needs: PAA./Youth sports programs do not happen without YOU! Truly the coaches, assistant coaches and team parent volunteers are directly responsible for the success of our program. All coaches are certified with the *National Youth Sports Coaches Assn. (N.Y.S.C.A)*. A three year program. The initial certification clinic is 3 hrs. in length, emphasizing the importance of quality youth programs through proper coaching techniques and commitment to youth, not winning at all costs. Assistant coaches may also attend these *certification clinics. Re-certification clinics* for 2nd and 3rd yr. coaches are 2 1/2 hrs. in length. Clinic fees are paid by PAA./Youth as long as you are coaching in PAA./Youth programs. ***Team Parents*** serve a vital service to the coaches and team. Calling team members, ordering uniforms, helping to arrange the team party at the end of the season are just some of the ways team parents assist their team. Teams will also need parents to volunteer as scorekeepers at games.

Team formation: For the most part players are grouped on teams formed by elementary geographical location, however when necessary PAA./Youth will mix players from several geographical locations when other school area teams are full. **Register as soon as possible to assure placement on a team. We are also in need for people to act as TEAM ORGANIZERS to help in the team formation process. If you are interested, please contact the PAA office at 858-7678 as soon as possible.
